COMPETITIVE AWARDS

Best-in-Show and 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place, and Honorable Mentions in each category according to the discretion of the judge. Best of show is a cash award TBD. Also two \$250.00 scholarships are awarded one Undergraduate and one Graduate.

RULES OF ENTRY

1. Entry fees are \$5.00 for the 1st 3 pieces and \$1.00 per each additional piece.
2. Each artist may enter work in the following categories: Oil • Watercolor • Printmaking • Three-Dimensional • Photography • Acrylic • Drawing • Fiber • Mixed Media • Graphic Design • Digital Imagery • Ceramics • Manually Rendered Floorplan - Digitally Rendered Floorplan - Manually Rendered Perspective (multiple perspectives of the same project can be 1 submission) - Digitally Rendered Perspective (multiple perspectives of the same project can be 1 submission) • Product Design • **Other categories may be added as needed**
3. The entries will be reviewed by a committee of faculty and narrowed to the top 100 works. An outside juror will then select forty pieces to be shown in the gallery and from these the juror will award the ribbons.
4. **Work submitted for preliminary judging does not have to be framed but should be presented to show the work at its best.** Each piece must be labeled on the back for identification. An entry label should be attached to the back of each piece in the lower right corner.
5. Two-dimensional work must not exceed 48 inches by 48 inches, including the frame, and 75 pounds.
6. **All selected 2D work must be framed**, with no exposed glass or raw edges, and ready for hanging (with picture wire - no saw tooth hangers). An entry label should be attached to the back of each piece in the lower right corner.
7. Three-dimensional work must not exceed 48 inches by 48 inches and 100 pounds. Ready to install, if you need special pedestals or display apparatus you are responsible for them (see Mr. Jolly). All selected 3D work must be prepared and ready for display. An entry label should be attached to each piece in an appropriate spot.
8. All work must be original to the entering artist, not more than 2 years old, and not have been shown in a previous Mississippi College Competitive Show. Copies of other works will not be accepted, nor will anything made from commercial kits, molds, or designs.
9. All work must be hand delivered to the Gore Gallery, according to the schedule. No work accepted for the show will be released prior to the official closing of the show.
10. All precautions will be exercised in the handling of art submitted to the show. However, neither the school nor the gallery assumes responsibility for any work beyond that of normal good care and will not be responsible for work that is not picked up during scheduled times.
11. The school and the gallery reserves the right to photograph work for publicity purposes, to refuse any entry and to reassign categories.

February 23, 2018 | Selected works for show must be framed, ready for hanging, labeled and returned to the Gallery by 3:00 pm. Late works are subject to not being hung.

February 27, 2018 Guest Juror will select winning entries

February 27, 2018.... Show hung and juror does final judging

February 28 - March 30, 2018.....Show opens to public in the Spaugh Gallery

March 4, 2018.....Artist Reception and Awards: 2:00 – 4:00 P.M.

March 30, 2018.....3:00 P.M. show closes
